BELLEVILLE, ONTARIO (AP) -- The Science Fair began in Belleville in 1960 and the following year in 1961 the Rotary Club began its sponsorship. In 1965 a hobby show was added held at the Belleville Armories. Top entries were selected to participate in the Canada-wide Science Fair. Over the years many entries from Belleville have won national recognition. This Club project continued until 1979.
